REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS SPRING 2023

Scholarship for Teaching and Learning Grants

I. OVERVIEW

The Center for Teaching and Learning is pleased to announce a grant opportunity for SoTL (Scholarship of Teaching and Learning) projects. Grants of \$500 will be funded for three consecutive semesters beginning Fall 2023. Two grants (each spanning three semesters) are available. To submit your proposal follow the guidelines below.

II. PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

The research must meet the criteria for a SoTL project—it must be scholarly work completed by faculty members that addresses questions of teaching and learning, draws evidence-based conclusions, subjects the findings of the research to peer review, and makes the research public.

The proposal is limited to a 500-word maximum and must include the following:

- The question that the faculty member(s) desires to research
- An explanation describing how this research will contribute to both the teaching and learning of the faculty member(s) as well as Jacksonville University at large
- Description of the present stage of research that the faculty member(s) is in (e.g. formation, literature review, design, or collection)
- An outline of measurable goals that will help the faculty member(s) advance to the next stages of the respective research

Proposals are due electronically by March 10, 2023 by 5:00 p.m. to CTL@ju.edu. Proposals received after the due date will not be considered.

III. PROPOSAL SELECTION

Proposals will be reviewed by a committee and selection will be made upon the completion of the application, the strength of the research question, and its relevance to teaching and learning.

IV. RECIPIENT RESPONSIBILITIES

If the grant is received, the recipient will be required to submit three end of semester reports that will include a summary of the research project and progress on the project.
